Noun Hope, to anticipate (usually with pleasure/eagerness), expectation and confidence. Thus, more than wishful thinking, this word refers to a certain outlook.

This word is part of the *Pauline triad*, which regularly appear in Paul's letters. The other two words are <u>love</u> [2] and <u>faith</u> [3]. The triad is found in<u>1</u>:

- Romans 5:2-5
- 1 Corinthians 13:13
- Galatians 5:5
- Colossians 1:4-5
- 1 Thessalonians 1:3
- 1 Thessalonians 5:8

Additionally, the triad is also found in Hebrews 6:10-12, Hebrews 10:22-24, 1 Peter 1:3-8 and 1 Peter 1:21-22.
