Maps

I am no cartographer. Even less than that, I am terrible at drawing simple figures, let alone accurate descriptions. These maps, therefore, are not my own. I have sourced them from various places on the Internet. They are all in scalable vector graphics (SVG) format and have all been released under Creative Commons, the GNU Free Documentation or similar permissive license.

At present the maps are just static displays, usually scaled. For them to be useful, you'll probably want to view them through some external SVG viewer. To get at the SVG source, right click on the map and go to "View Frame Source" (or copy the frame address or something similar). I'll look around and see if I can maybe find a spiffy JavaScript SVG viewer, but in the mean time this will have to do.

Please be aware that, at the time of publication, the SVG maps were only being correctly displayed by the following browsers:

- Firefox 3.5
- Opera 9.6
- Chrome 4

The following browsers had problems displaying the SVG maps:

- Internet Explorer 8: seemingly did not even attempt to load the graphics
- Chrome 2: loads the graphics, but does not scale all of them correctly

Always make sure you are using the newest version of your preferred browser!
